In an effort to provide the community with information about M-NCPPC,

Department of Parks and Recreation's

Tennis Court Maintenance and

Replacement program, the Department is sharing the following information:

## **TENNIS COURT REPLACEMENT CYCLES**

- Full court replacements are completed throughout Prince George's County on a 12-year cycle. (Padgett's Corner Tennis Courts received a full replacement in the spring of 2012; the next scheduled replacement would be 2024.)
- Prior to the next scheduled full replacement, a soil assessment will be conducted to assess the existing subgrade conditions.
- A Capital Improvement Project (CIP) request will be submitted for the 2023 budget cycle to allocate funding for a geotechnical assessment. If the subgrade condition is found unsuitable during the assessment, additional CIP funding will be requested to resolve the issue.

## TENNIS COURT SURFACES

- A complete recoating of surfaces was completed in fall 2019.
- Surface material cracks are scheduled to be fixed in spring 2020.


## ONGOING MAINTENANCE

- Conditions are monitored regularly by the Department's maintenance and facility staff.
- Any cracks, dead spots, and/or damage will be identified.
- As issues are identified, resolutions will be sought in a timely manner.
